White Band—Jacket potato and fillings.

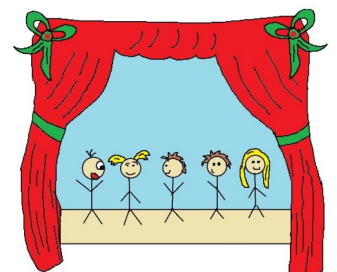


Christmas Play letters
