Try to set aside time each Friday for a Spelling test.

- <u>ABC Order-</u> Write out the spelling list in alphabetical order.
- Word Parts Write your words.
   Then use a coloured pencil to divide the words into syllables. e.g. jumping caterpillar
- Vowel Spotlight Write your words using one colour for the vowels and another colour for the consonants. (vowels: a, e, i, o, u)
- Other Hand Write each word 5 times, switching the hand you write it with each time. Say the word as you spell it.
- <u>Silly Sentences</u> Write 3 or more sentences that use all your spelling words.

Remember you can also use spelling apps such as Spelling Shed to work on your spelling too.
