# THE SCHOOL DAY

In Year 1 there is a more structured timetable covering the core subjects (English, Maths and Science) and foundation subjects (History, Geography, PSHE, RE, Computing, Art & Design, DT, Music and PE)

#### PE

- · Our PE day is Friday
- Children are required to come to school in their PE kit and wear their coloured
   House T-Shirt. We will be doing PE outside as much as possible therefore
   children should also have a dark pair of jogging bottoms and hoodie depending
   on weather.
- · Children are allowed to wear trainers (Velcro) on PE day.
- No earrings on PE days Please ensure that all earrings are taken out during P.E days. Essex County Council guidelines state 'school children are no longer allowed to tape up their ears to cover earrings for PE or other sporting activities. This is due to injuries received by several pupils across Essex. Therefore children will need to be able to independently remove their earrings or they will be unable to take part'
- · All long hair should also be tied up. No novelty hairbands.

#### UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS

- Please ensure all items are named.
- Please remember coats/jackets- we do go out to play even if it is raining!
- Black shoes no trainers except on PE day
- No naíl varnísh
- · Water bottle every day please no juice or flavoured water
- Children in KS1 should not be bringing in their own sanitiser

# <u>ASSESSMENT</u>

- Children are assessed in reading by Colour Band at least half termly but it is ongoing.
- Books will be changed weekly (to begin with) but children should have their books and reading diaries in their book bag everyday.
- · Termly Assessments in Maths, English and Reading
- Children are assessed (set by the Government) as
  - O Working Towards the Expected Standard
  - o Working at the Expected Standard
  - O Working at Greater Depth within the Expected Standard

# HOMEWORK

- · Ideally your child should be reading everyday
- We have recently signed up to an online homework
  platform that will cover Maths and English skills. More
  details to follow.

#### BEHAVIOUR

- Rewards Children are rewarded using house points, texts, postcards, Star of the Day and Star of the Week
- Sanctions We have traffic light warning charts in classrooms which may result in children missing some of their playtime or lunchtime.
- Detentions\* Certain circumstances may result in a lunchtime detention. Should a child be in detention 3 times in a half term, a meeting will be arranged with the parents, and class teacher. If detentions continue then further meetings will involve Key Stage Leader, Deputy and Head teacher.
