Organisation

- *Please inform us via text if children are allowed to walk home or will be picked up by somebody else
- *Children should bring water bottles to school every day
 these can be refilled in the classroom
- *They should bring fruit and vegetables as a snack
- *Children should ensure they are wearing appropriate clothing for the weather including proper school shoes (no black trainers). They may need to wear layers as classroom doors and windows are open all day.

Organisation

A record of this will be given to you each term.


Homework


- *Children should now complete their quizzes at home on https://ukhosted84.renlearn.co.uk/2231238/
