Who are the new superheroes? Can you describe one of the new characters, what is their superpower?

Parents: Talk to your child about the different characters first before they start writing. Who is their favourite? Why?

What happens next?

Can you write a new adventure for Supertato? Is he going to meet a new baddie? Who is going to rescue and how?

Parents: Encourage your child to remember their capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. Ask your child to read their sentence aloud to check it makes sense.

- Read everyday Read your school book, read a book from home, listen to someone else read and point out the sounds you know, listen to a story on audible... just keep reading!
- Practise reading and writing tricky words people, called, could, looked, asked, their. You could also write the tricky words into a sentence.

Using conjunctions 'and' and 'because'

Do you remember what conjunctions are? They help to make your sentences longer and more interesting. Can you write some sentences that include the words 'and' or 'because' e.g. I like to eat chocolate and cake. I do not want to go outside today because it is too cold.

Parents: Ask your child if they remember the mnemonic to help spell 'because' correctly.
