early	search
learn	unearth
heard	earl
earn	rehearse

Follow the PowerPoint online for a daily activity. Or choose a different activity daily to complete. Try to set aside time each Friday for a Spelling test.

- **ABC Order-** Write out the spelling list in alphabetical order.
- **Word Parts** - Write your words. Then use a coloured pencil to divide the words into syllables. e.g. **jumping**
Caterpillar
- **Vowel Spotlight** - Write your words using one colour for the vowels and another colour for the consonants. (vowels: a, e, I, o, u)
- **Other Hand** - Write each word 5 times, switching the hand you write it with each time. Say the word as you spell it.
- **Silly Sentences** Write 3 or more sentences that use all your spelling words.

Remember you can also use spelling apps such as Spelling Shed to work on your spelling too or the spelling sheet we gave you before we left.
