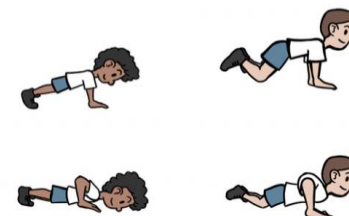
Lesson 6 is a tricky lesson with loops. Have a go at this lesson and try to use the shorthand for codes such as fd for forward.

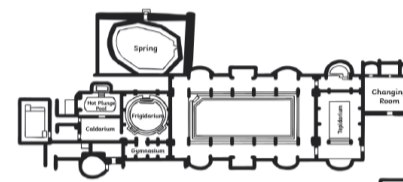
