

EYFS Phonics/Reading Activities

Date: 29.06.20 Focus: Guided Reading-Scarecrow letter Phonics-

All of these activities will be taught in school-phonics on both days they are in and Guided Reading on both days they are in. If you are continuing to home school your child then you can do all 4 activities at home.

Lesson	Activity	Guidance for Parents
1	Guided reading- This will follow the same format every week and it is one the children are familiar with. There is a letter from a Scarecrow attached. You are going to read this with a grown up.	*Talk to the children about the format. Is it a poem? A story? Can they identify that this is a letter? *The children love 'Echo' reading. You read a line to them and they copy you. They really enjoy it when you use funny voices.
2	Guided Reading Share the letter again. Can you remember why the scarecrow wanted your help?	Questions that you can ask your child about the letter. *What is the scarecrow called? *Where does the scarecrow live? *What is the scarecrows job? *Why are there not many vegetables left? *Can you think of something he could make to feed the birds? *Have you ever written a letter? Who did you write it to?
3	These are our new blends this week. Can you say the blend? Can you think of other words with the same blends at the beginning?. Have a look around the room, what can you find?	Encourage your child to work out the blend, can they think of other words with the sounds, mix them up with other blends we have been looking atcan they find the new ones?
4	Can you remember our new blends this week? We are going to play a game on Phonics Play called - buried treasure. This is a fun game where you can read the words and decide if they are real or fake.	Phonics play- you can log on and it is free to play. If you can't access it- write out some of the words we have been practising and make up some words- see if your child can recognise them. ©
