2	Talk about our bubbles from yesterday. Today we are making 'Wish bubbles'! Talk about who else you would like in your bubble. Is there another friend or teacher you	Draw their own 'wish' bubbles - who would they add to their bubble if they could? Can they
SCHOOL ACTIVTY	would like to add? A family member? Maybe you want to add someone useful - a cleaner, a chef, a hairdresser?	justify their choices? It can be serious (friends/family) or funny (I might add a chef to mine!!)
		Cut them out and stick them around your own bubble.
3	Look at the pictures. Who has enjoyed learning about dinosaurs? Can anyone name any? How many do we know? Do you know the names of the dinosaurs on the sheet? We are going to write some sentences about the dinosaurs. What is a sentence? How do we know it is a sentence and not just a label or caption? It has a capital letter and a full stop.	Read the words to your child. Talk about what they mean and help them to write a sentence about the dinosaur. Say the sentence they want to write - count how many words they need to write - capital letter to start - full stop at the end.
