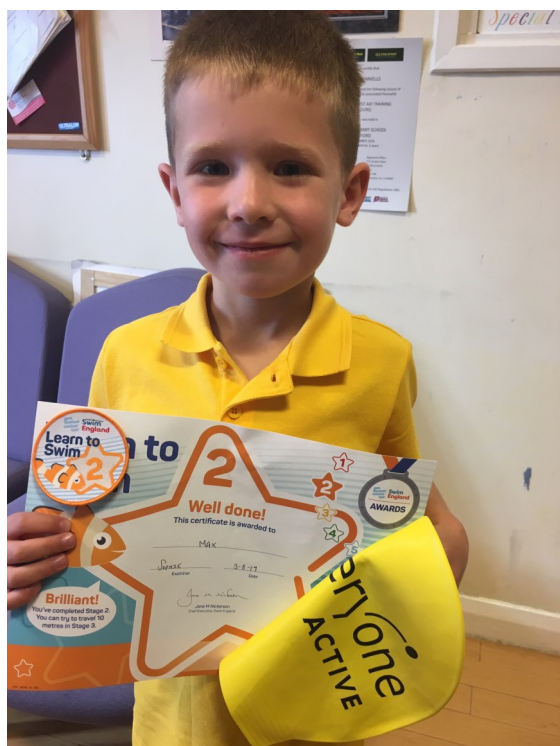

We have enjoyed meeting you all at home visits this week.

We have had a lovely first day today and look forward to next week starting our topic of Marvellous Me.



It was super exciting on Monday as we had a special delivery from Madam Dragon...a mysterious egg that we need to look after. She also sent us a book about a Dragon School to help us with our story writing skills, which we have already started working on.



In Year 2 we have started to talk about our Rule Britannia topic. Children have compared London now to the past which will lead us into The Great Fire of London. We are reading 'Not Now Bernard' in English and focusing on Place Value in Maths.



In Year 3, we have started our Stone Age to Iron Age topic.

In English we have been learning about and reading Fables, which are stories with a moral. A moral is a message that teaches you a lesson e.g. 'A kindness is never wasted'.
