Geography/History

Last week you made your own compass. Can you remember the name for each compass point and in the right order?

Did you know you can actually find North without a real compass, all you need is the sun. So fingers crossed it will be sunny this week. Follow the attached instructions and have a go at finding north in your own home.

Parents: Explain that the sun always rises in the east and sets in the west. That means that the sun's shadow points in the opposite direction. The first rock stands for west and the second rock stands for east. So if you make a point directly in the middle of the rocks you can find north
